

SJLBC - 2020 Winter League

Format

The 2020 Winter League will be held at San Jose Lawn Bowls Club, over 3 consecutive **Saturdays: Jan. 11, 18, 25**. Rained out days will be played on Saturday, Feb. 1.

This is a mixed or matched pairs event with a maximum number of 14 teams (no odd number of teams). 3 games played each week. Entry fee is \$60 per team.

3 bowls per player. **2 sets of 5 ends per game**. 1 pt. for winning a set, 1/2 pt. for a tied set, 0 points for a loss. 1 pt. bonus awarded for overall point total after 2 sets. One end tie-breaker if points tied after both sets are played. Standings will be based on total game points. Prizes will be awarded to approximately 30% of teams entered.

Each game lasts a maximum of 1.5 hours. A warning bell will be sounded when there are 10 minutes left. No jacks rolled after the warning bell. If the game is not completed by the expired time, the score will be the final result of the last end played.

PIMD rules apply. Dress is winter casual. Bring your own lunch. Snacks provided. Beverages will be available for purchase.

The start of the tournament is 9:30 am. A penalty of 1 point, per 10 min. for being late, will be assessed. After 30 minutes, the game is considered a forfeit with a final score of 3-0.

Comments

- Should a rain out occur during play, game is scored as of the last end played.
- One substitute allowed per team – sub. must play the lead position. It is the team captain or skip's responsibility to find a substitute for their team. Teams not able to field a team will constitute a forfeit with a final score of 0-3 per game.
- The head umpire will be delegated by the tournament director to resolve any conflicts pertaining to the Rules of Bowls. Head umpire decisions are final.

Scoring

- 1 pt. for winning a set, 1/2 pt. for a tie, 0 points for a loss. 1 pt. bonus awarded for overall point total after 2 sets. One end tie- breaker if points tied after 2 sets. Skips must verify game results and sign each other's scorecard. The winning skip is to turn in the scorecards to the tournament director for official scoring.
- The total point score is 3 per game.

Prizes

- Prize money will likely be awarded to the top three to four places, based on the size of the field. Total game points will be used to determine final standings.
